For more than 25 years, the member municipalities of the Climate Alliance Luxembourg, together with the two supporting organizations Mouvement Ecologique and ASTM, and their indigenous partners from the Global South, have been committed to local climate action and global climate justice.

In Luxembourg, 40 municipalities are members of the Climate Alliance, and more than two-thirds of the population live in a Climate Alliance municipality.

Because our lifestyle has a direct impact on some of the most threatened peoples and places on Earth, the Climate Alliance links local action with global responsibility.

With over 1,800 members from 27 European countries, the Climate Alliance is the world's largest city network dedicated to climate protection.

ENERGY CARAVAN

The Energy Caravan is a campaign by the Climate Alliance Luxembourg aimed at raising public awareness about energy-efficient home renovations. It uses an innovative outreach approach by bringing energy advice directly to the residents, rather than waiting for them to seek it out. Through targeted, door-to-door outreach in a selected neighborhood, the initiative is led by the municipality, which actively approaches its citizens — reversing the typical dynamic. The responsibility no longer lies with the individual to contact the municipality; instead, the municipality takes the first step. If residents agree, their contact details are passed on to the relevant energy advisor from the Klima-Agence, who then contacts them to arrange a consultation. The energy consultation takes place directly in the residents' homes. In this way, the Energy Caravan actively helps to promote and expand awareness of the existing energy advisory services.

In 2024, Energy Caravans took place in the municipalities of Junglinster and Hesperange, and were very well received by the public.

SOIL PROTECTION IS CLIMATE PROTECTION

In 2024, the Climate Alliance Luxembourg, in collaboration with CELL, once again offered a series of four workshops for hobby gardeners as well as facilitators and project leaders of community gardens. The thematic focus was on the careful use of soil as a resource, covering topics such as crop rotation, soil cultivation, composting, and more. Additionally, a two-day introductory course on permaculture was offered.



SAFE ON THE BIKE

Following a pilot project in Strassen in 2022, Climate Alliance Luxembourg, together with ProVelo.lu asbl, launched new initiatives in June 2024 in the municipalities of Kehlen and Roeser to improve school routes and accompany children on their bike commutes to school over several weeks. These efforts were made possible in large part thanks to the active involvement of many parents and members of local commissions. In Niederanven, the "Vélobus" was reactivated during the warmer months of 2024.

GOGO VELO

After ten years of the "TOUR du DUERF" campaign, 2024 saw the launch of the new cycling campaign GoGo VELO, in partnership with ProVelo asbl and with



financial support from the Ministry of Mobility. Around 600 participants collectively covered a distance equal to nearly four trips around the Earth. In 2025, the campaign will expand to include high schools and broader regions.



MUNICIPAL CO2 ACCOUNTING

As part of the Climate Pact for Luxembourg municipalities, Climate Alliance Luxembourg was tasked with establishing municipal CO₂ baseline assessments for all municipalities in the country using the ECOSpeed software. Unfortunately, the available data proved insufficient for this purpose, particularly in the areas of mobility and the economy.

WARM SWEATER DAY

In 2023, following an international example, Climate Alliance Luxembourg launched the "Warm Sweater Day" in Luxembourg. The goal of this initiative is to raise awareness about saving energy at home and in the workplace — a message that remains highly relevant in times of climate and energy crises. The campaign continued in 2024, promoted through social media channels.



SEMINARS

Together with partners such as Mouvement Ecologique, Oekozentrale Pafendall, and Pro-Vélo, several webinars and conferences were offered throughout 2024. The recordings of these events can be viewed on our website: klimabuendnis.lu.

CLIMATE PACT

The coordination team participated in the meetings of Climate Pact partners alongside the Klima-Agence and took an active role in shaping the workshop on "Adaptation to Climate Change" during the "Klimapakt-Dag."
