

# Stop the backdoor imposition of the EU-Mercosur trade deal

A dangerous manoeuvre is underway. After the European Parliament asked the European Court of Justice to review the EU-Mercosur agreement, the deal should have been paused. Instead, the European Commission and the Council are exploring ways to push it into force provisionally — without waiting for the Court's ruling and without approval from elected MEPs.

This is a blatant attempt to bypass democratic scrutiny. A massive trade deal with far-reaching consequences for the climate, Indigenous peoples, farmers, and workers could start applying before democratic institutions have had their say.

Provisional application now would silence citizens' voices and undermine the very foundations of EU democracy. Decisions of this magnitude must not be imposed through procedural shortcuts and backroom tactics.
