The Oekofest program

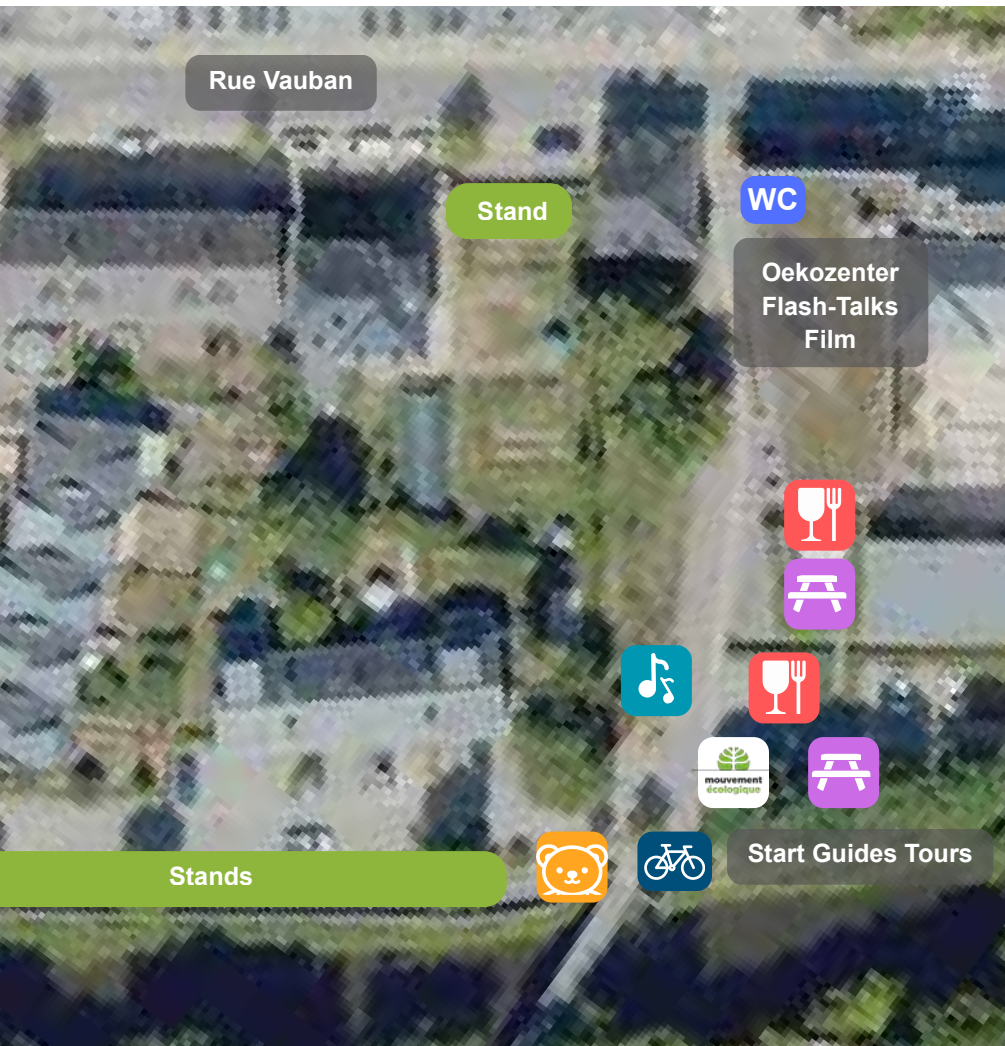
In 2026, too, the Oekofest will be spread across Pfaffenthal, so you can stroll around at your leisure (in the exhibition areas). The affected streets and the "Spidolsgaard" are closed to traffic. Only residential spaces marked out at the entrance. There are very few parking spaces in Pfaffenthal, so it's best to use the bus stop is right next to the festival. Parking is available at the Glacis (the footpath to the Oekofest).

- * **Bus:** AVL bus no. 23 or no. 26, Vauban or Theiwesbuer stop
- * **By foot / by bike:** If you need a parking space / Glacis car park / Pafendall panoramic lift
- * **Train:** Pfaffenthal-Kirchberg station
- * **Cycle:** Train and PC1 (additional cycle racks have been set up for the Oekofest).

Every hour on the hour between 1.00 pm and 4.00 pm, experts will give a stimulating 20-minute talk in the main hall on the first floor of the Oekozentrum on a practical topic relating to sustainable development – followed by 15 minutes for questions and discussion with the audience. SMARTLY MANAGING YOUR HOME'S ENERGY SUPPLY – WITH A HEMS

A Home Energy Management System (HEMS) connects and controls the electrical appliances in the home to ensure that renewable energy is used as efficiently as possible.

For example, an electric car can be charged when there is a particularly high level of solar power available or when electricity prices are low. This reduces electricity costs whilst also contributing to the stability of the electricity grid.

Sharing self-generated solar power with neighbours, family members or colleagues is becoming increasingly easy. The so-called 'Partage d'électricité' scheme makes it possible to pass on or purchase electricity from a photovoltaic system on attractive terms.

This benefits both the producers, who can make better use of the electricity they generate, and the consumers, who receive solar power at a lower cost.

WATER CARRIER RUN FOR CHILDREN

Did you know? In the past, there were numerous water carriers in Pfaffenthal who supplied the wealthy residents of the Upper Town with fresh water. Discover the sculpture by the artist Menny Olinger, 'de mitte Waasserdréier'.

MUERBELSMILLEN

The origins of the Mohrfels Mill date back to the 11th century. Most recently, and until 1985, it served as a mustard mill. Following extensive renovation, the building was officially opened in 2017.

Experience the old milling technology, which is still in working order today, with its waterwheel, gear wheels for power transmission and millstones.

In the exhibition, you'll learn more about the history of the mill and the secrets of mustard production.

RATS IN THE CITY – A SUCCESS STORY!

HOW CAN SOLAR ENERGY BE RECONCILED WITH HERITAGE CONSERVATION?

This question is at the heart of a tour through Pfaffenthal, which forms part of the UNESCO buffer zone surrounding the old town and fortifications. Using an augmented reality app, participants discover how coloured photovoltaic systems blend into the cityscape, evaluate design options in a playful way and weigh up costs, energy yield and aesthetics. A walk through the neighbourhood, the view from the Pfaffenthal lift and a group mapping exercise to identify suitable buildings round off the experience.

FILM FROM 2026 : D'KATASTROPH (LUX)

A documentary in the Luxembourgish language about one of the worst disasters in Luxembourg since the

The Second World War; the devastating gas explosion in Pfaffenthal on 30 May 1976, which destroyed several blocks of houses and claimed the lives of three people. It was produced by freelance cameraman Claude Pauly in collaboration with the Pafendall-Sichenhaff Association (Jean-André Stamm, Gusty Feider), with the support of the City of Luxembourg.

Drawing on eyewitness accounts and historical footage, it shows how the evening unfolded and what consequences the explosion had for the neighbourhood and its residents.

Naturwelten has been offering organic and fairly produced clothing and other textiles for over 30 years. Treating people and the environment with respect is their top priority.

Naturwelten is running a workshop where children and adults can paint jute bags (organic & fair trade) using eco-friendly textile dyes.



ORTEA



Ortea is an iced tea produced in Luxembourg. Made from stinging nettles, honey and fruit, it impresses with its natural and subtly sweet flavour – a refreshing alternative for anyone who cares about what's in their drink. Ortea

shares a stand with BAC, where you can sample the iced tea on its own or in a cocktail. You can also enjoy the iced tea at the Mouvement Ecologique's drinks stalls!

PAFENDALL POTTERY

Pafendall Pottery is a small pottery studio on the banks of the Alzette in Pfaffenthal, where all pieces are made by hand with a focus on sustainability. Cups, vases, plates and bowls are often decorated with botanical impressions of local flowers and leaves. The pottery also produces terracotta ollas – traditional vessels for gentle watering of plants.



SOLAR-ZUKUNFT

Discover the future of renewable energy systems that are transforming our cities and landscapes. As an interdisciplinary project at the University of Luxembourg, Solar-Zukunft investigates how colored solar panels can blend harmoniously into their surroundings while maintaining high energy efficiency.



SICONA UND LÖLLJER GAART

The nature conservation organisation SICONA introduces you to the diversity of wild plants. As well as the LUX mixes, you can also purchase the 'Wëllplanzesom Lëtzebuerg' perennials grown by 'Lölljer Gaart', helping to make your garden attractive to pollinators.

SICONA also provides advice and information on creating and maintaining flower meadows and wild perennial beds.



TERRA

TERRA are the pioneers of community-supported agriculture in Luxembourg. With fresh, chemical-free vegetables, they have been demonstrating for years – practically next door on the Eicherfeld – that there is another way to farm.

At their stand, they'll be presenting their farm and demonstrating live how to turn fresh cabbage into crisp sauerkraut. Anyone who fancies it can lend a hand with the various steps throughout the day!



VINOTECA

Vinoteca.lu was founded in 2000 with the aim of helping restaurants to create their wine lists. A wine shop was soon opened on the “Place du Théâtre” in Luxembourg City to attract private customers as well.

When selecting winemakers, particular emphasis is placed on regional origin and environmentally friendly production methods, meaning that the range now comprises more than 100 wines from Luxembourg and over 600 organically grown wines. So-called ‘natural wines’ are also becoming increasingly prominent in Vinoteca.lu’s range.



WOXX

How is a newspaper produced? At the WOXX stand, young and old alike can immerse themselves in the world of journalism in a fun way and create their own headlines.

There’s also the chance to take part in a competition with lots of great prizes.



LIVING LIBRARY LUXEMBOURG

The Living Library Luxembourg, organised by the “Zentrum fir politesch Bildung (Centre for Political Education)”, invites you to meet people rather than harbour prejudices. ‘Living books’ share their personal stories and strike up conversations with visitors.
